

Days of Creation

Age: 5-8

Time: 2 days

Scripture References for Creation:

Day 1: Genesis 1: 1-5

Day 2: Genesis 1: 6-8

Day 3: Genesis 1: 9-13

Day 4: Genesis 1: 14-19

Day 5: Genesis 1: 20-23

Day 6: Genesis 1: 24-31

Day 7: Genesis 2: 1-3

Activity Supplies: Coloring supplies (color pencils, markers, or paint), Plain paper plates, googly eyes, cotton balls, glue, Scissors, white paper

Optional: string, foam stickers, feathers.

Instructions:

1. Read Day 1 of creation (Gen. 1: 1-5)
 - a. Take 1 plate and color half of the paper plate black and the other half a bright color. This is to symbolize God dividing the light and dark.



2. Read Day 2 of creation (Gen. 1: 6-8)

- a. Take 1 plate and color it a light blue. Then take a darker blue color and show the water. Then glue some cotton ball above where the water is symbolized.



3. Read Day 3 of creation (Gen. 1: 9-13)


- a. Take 1 paper plate. Color the top half with blue to symbolize the sky. Then color the bottom half with green to symbolize the earth. Draw or find another creative way to show plant life.



4. Read Day 4 of creation (Gen 1: 14-19)

- a. Take 1 paper plate and color part of it grey and the other part a yellow color. (You can add a curve to make it more interesting. Then cut out stars from the white

paper. Take these stars and glue them along the line that separates the grey and yellow part.



5. Read Day 5 of creation (Gen 1: 20-23)

- a. Take 1 paper plate and cut it in half. Color the two different halves different colors. On one of the halves draw feathers and a beak, add a googly eye, this will represent a bird. On the other half add scales and a googly eye. Cut a triangle out of white paper and color it the same color as the half you are working on. Glue the triangle on to show a tail. Add feathers and sequins to the fish and birds to add personality.



6. Read Day 6 of creation (Gen. 1: 24-31)

- a. Take one paper plate and color it. Add googly eyes, draw on a nose and mouth.
Add hair either by drawing it in, using string, or other materials.



7. Read Day 7 of creation (Gen. 2: 1-3)

- a. There is no craft for this day since it is God's day of rest. Take the day to review all the days of creation.
